commercial and residential properties.

- Business, including partnership disputes, breach of contract, fraud, intentional interference, unfair competition, and collection disputes.

Prior to or at the mediation, all participants are asked to sign a confidentiality agreement.

Ms. Wagner requests that briefs up to 10 pages be delivered to no later than seven days prior to the mediation. The briefs may be sent by fax (310-712-8108) or email (ewagner@swattys.com) in Word, WordPerfect or PDF formats. The

brief may be done in either pleading or letter format, and should include a factual summary, cast of characters, areas of significant factual/legal disagreements, obstacles to settlement (including personality conflicts, evidentiary problems, procedural issues, and so on), and settlement history, if any.

Mediation Facilities
